1. NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES

- 1.1. The Regional and District Authorities shall nominate candidates for the Executive Committee in accordance with the SA Sailing Constitution.

2. VOTING FOR NOMINATIONS

- 2.1. Every member of the relevant Region and District, may vote for its choice of such number of members to be elected to that Region or Districts Executive Committee, in accordance with the SA Sailing Constitution.

3. REGIONAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETINGS

- 3.1. Each Regional Executive Committee shall routinely meet at least 4 (four) times a year, of which 1 (one) meeting will deal with the AGM and matters pertaining thereto, at least 1 (one) meeting will have as a part of its agenda matters of strategy, policy and programs including matters of performance of the various committees and the progress against the strategic intentions of SA Sailing and at least 1 (one) meeting will have, as a part of its agenda, matters of budgets and financial performance and planning. At each of these meetings, in addition to the item of focused activity already mentioned, the Regional Executive Committee shall execute oversight over the affairs of SA Sailing in the Region.
- 3.2. The minutes of all Regional Executive Committee meetings shall be distributed to the members of the Regional Executive Committee, SA Sailing National, and the Region's Affiliated Clubs and Classes.

4. REGIONAL AUTHORITIES: GEOGRAPHIC ALLOCATIONS

- 4.1. The Regional Authorities, of the Regions as Council may determine from time to time, due regard being given to the convenience of closely located sailing populations, balanced against considerations of administration costs, shall be:
 - 4.1.1. [Intentionally blank];
 - 4.1.2. Eastern Cape Sailing Authority, the area of Eastern Cape Province;
 - 4.1.3. Western Cape Sailing Authority, the area of Western Cape Province;
 - 4.1.4. KwaZulu-Natal Sailing Authority, the area of the KwaZulu-Natal Province; and
 - 4.1.5. Northern Region Sailing Authority, the area of the Limpopo, Mpumalanga, Gauteng, North West, Free State, and the Northern Cape Province.
- 4.2. SA Sailing will, at all times, endeavour to align the Regional Authorities geographic allocations with those published by Government, but may give

dispensation to an affiliated club, although in one geographic region, to be considered part of a different geographic region, after written motivation from that club.

5. REGIONAL AUTHORITIES: REGIONAL BY-LAWS

- 5.1. Each Regional Authority shall administer and manage the affairs of SA Sailing in its Region according to this and the Regional By-Law 7.

6. DISTRICT EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETINGS

- 6.1. Each District Executive Committee shall routinely meet at least 3 (three) times a year, of which 1 (one) meeting will deal with the AGM and matters pertaining thereto, at least 1 (one) meeting will have as a part of its agenda matters of strategy, policy and programs including matters of performance of the various committees and the progress against the strategic intentions of SA Sailing, and at least 1 (one) meeting will have as a part of its agenda matters of budgets and financial performance and planning. At each of these meetings, in addition to the item of focused activity already mentioned, the District Executive Committee shall execute oversight over the affairs of SA Sailing in the Region.
- 6.2. The minutes of all District Executive Committee meetings shall be distributed to the members of the District Executive Committee, the Regional Executive Committee, and the District's Affiliated Clubs and Classes.

7. DISTRICT AUTHORITIES: GEOGRAPHIC ALLOCATION

- 7.1. The District Authority boundaries shall strictly follow the geographic boundaries of the Municipal districts of the Republic of South Africa.
