Top yacht on its way to the Cape

GET More Fun, the recent line-honours winner of the Crystic Beachcomber Crossing, will sail today for Cape Town after it was sold last night to Cape company Tuna Marine for more than R1 000 000.

Commander John Martin, skipper of second-placed Crystic Beachcomber Crossing entrant Tuna Marine Voortrekker II, will skipper Get More Fun on its voyage to the Cape.

Mr Brian Cohen, chairman of the Tuna Marine Group, said last night that the yacht, which will be renamed Tuna Marine, would be raced in the upcoming Rothmans Week (December), the Agulhas Race (February, 1990) and the Dias Trophy Race to Lisbon (March, 1990).

Mr Cohen said that 24-hour negotiations earlier this week between Tuna Marine and Get More Fun owner, Mr Dave Rees, resulted in a deal being struck.
