DURBAN YACHTING REPORT SOON

A FULL report concerning the solution to the chronic shortage of mooring facilities for yachts in Durban harbour, is to be submitted to the City Engineer and Harbour Engineer shortly.

The urgent demand for moorings has been continuing in Durban for 11 years.

After an intensive study of the yacht mooring problem, the Yacht Basin Development Committee have compiled a complex report for the relevant authorities.

The proposed site will probably be behind the existing row of boats near the PYC jetty, with accommodation for 60-70 yachts.

More than 25 new yachts are unable to be launched in the bay because of the lack of moorings.

If the go-ahead is given, it is understood that development and dredging of the proposed site will take less than six months.
