**THE Sea Harvest Ocean Race from Cape Town to St Helena Bay and Saldanha Bay which starts in Cape Town on March 3 at 7pm is developing into a very exciting race.**

**For the first time in the race's history the L34 class will be there in force and they should put on quite a performance.**

**There is also an entry coming from Bank of Lisbon sailed by Tony Abbot and a previous Rothmans Week winner Gwaap sailed by Mark Stevens will also be in with a chance.**

**The race starts in Table Bay and the yachts go round a mark at Cape Columbine, then a mark vessel in St Helena Bay and on to the finish line in Saldanha, covering approximately 160 nautical miles.**
