

BONGERS WINS LIPTON CUP

CAPE TOWN. — With only one race in the 1968 Lipton Cup series left yesterday Bobby Bongers, in Trickson, has scored only three penalty points in the first three races, which makes him overall winner of the challenge, no matter how badly he fares in the final race this morning. Far behind is Frank Waller in Tarpon, with 18.7 points.

Close behind Trickson was Tintomara (skipper Alan Duncan)—so close, in fact, that Tintomara immediately ran up a red protest flag, alleging that Bongers had run her down to leeward of the finishing buoy, forcing her to ease off and allowing Bongers to slip through in the lead after a neck-and-neck tussle up the last long beat.

The race committee overruled the protest.—(Sapa.)
