Savage bounces back

Transvaal sailors revelled in the light conditions during the 1986 National laser slalom championships held off-shore Durban at the weekend.

More than 40 competitors who had pre-qualified at provincial level, assembled in Durban to determine the best yachtsman in their category.

Sailing was organised on a one-on-one basis with the winner of the best of three races moving into the next round.

After a shaky start in the open section, Bruce Savage of Natal won the title. He put out defending champion Dave Hibberd in the semifinals and Western Province slalom runner-up, Adrian Morris, in the quarterfinals.
