



Love Motors wins first stage

THE Royal Natal Yacht Club entry, Love Motors, skippered by Craig Lanham-Love won the first stage of the 1989 Joko Lipton Cup Challenge yacht race, which started in Table Bay yesterday.

Second was Zeekoevlei Yacht Club's SX Stainless Steel, skippered by Rick Nankin and Chris King, followed by Hollard Carguard, the University of Cape Town entry.

Sturrock Shipping, the Royal Cape Yacht Club yacht, was fourth with Joko, sailing under the Worcester

Yacht Club's colours, close on its heels. Two of the fleet were disqualified for jumping the start. They were Plastamid sailed by Colin Hancocks for Milnerton Aquatic Club and Omega Heatwave sailed by Percy Elston for Pennant Nine Yacht Club on the Vaal Dam.

The scoring system for this six race regatta is unusual because it does not allow a worst result to be discarded. These two yachts are therefore almost certainly out of contention from now on.
