Yacht To Sail Round World

PLYMOUTH. — Retired Royal Navy Commander Bill King (59) left Plymouth yesterday on his second attempt to sail non-stop round the world.

Commander King, who almost drowned when a hurricane capsized his boat off South Africa during a similar voyage 10 months ago, left Plymouth in a 42ft. schooner, Galway Blazer II.

He said he hopes to complete the 28,000-mile voyage in eight to 10 months. — (Sapa-Reuter.)
