

# SA yachts improve

WHILE the top five yachts in the Cape-to-Rio race hardly changed their order yesterday, the Durban ketch Cariad and Voortrekker improved their positions vastly.

Still heading the fleet are Ocean Spirit, Graybeard, Striana, Hamburg VII, Stormy and Jan Pott.

Voortrekker recovered from 14th to 7th place in line, and 21st to 17th on handicap.

Cariad was one of three tying for eighth place. Skippered by Krasni Sutic, she previously held 24th place. She is still nearly 30 hours behind the leaders on handicap.

In the handicap positions, four of Tuesday's leaders were still at the top, though in different order.

There was no report from the all-women sloop Sprinter, skippered by Molly Warr.

The French schooner Pen Duick III also did not report.

Yachts which have not reported since the start of the race are City of Springs, Ingwe, Ma'm'selle, Sandefjord, N a m a r IV and Wayfarer.
