John Goodwin's Albatros, again first on handicap, had moved up to second place over-all.

In actual position, Striana, the French ketch, is still leading, but is sixth on handicap.

After Albatros is the German Hamburg VII, followed by the Durban yacht Mercury (Bobby Nuttall) with Graybeard back to fifth place.

Gordon Webb's Pionier is lying third on handicap. Sprinter (Molly Warr) is slightly worse off at 28th.

Ingwe, the Durban Point ketch has at last reported — in last place and 510 miles behind the leader.

Pen Duick (for the second day) and Ocean Spirit were among the 23 boats which did not report their positions yesterday.
