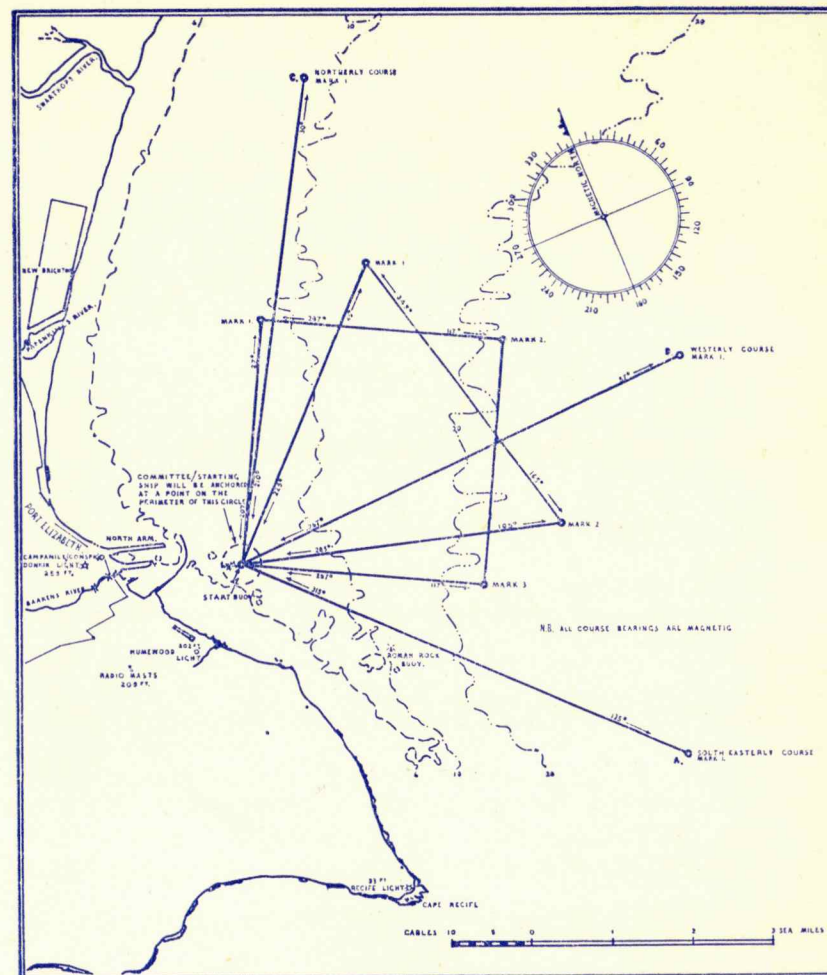
GENERAL INFORMATION
