

RIO RACE KETCH IS STILL ON THE WAY

CAPE-TO-RIO race officials are wondering whether the ketch Wayfarer will reach Cape Town in time for the race. Skipped by 70-year-old Peter Strong, she left Durban on December 31.

This is the first time Wayfarer has entered a race—she was launched only a short while ago. Mr. Strong is a marine architect and designed the yacht himself.

Mr. Gordon Burn Wood, president of the race committee, said that if Wayfarer was on the starting line at 4.30 p.m. to-morrow she would qualify as a starter.

A Hout Bay trawler reported sighting Wayfarer last night off Quoin Point, about 100 sea miles from Cape Town.
