

# Albatros leads on handicap

9-2-71

WITH Ocean Spirit over the line, Fortuna according to the positions reported early this morning was second in line (141 miles from Rio) and second on handicap — eight hours behind Albatros, which still leads on handicap, although sixth in line and 492 miles from Rio.

After Fortuna comes Graybeard (159 miles to go), and then Tabarly's Pen Duick, 183 miles away and 11 hours behind on handicap.

Albatros (at 4 p.m. yesterday when positions were reported) was 67 miles ahead of Mercury, which was joint eighth in line with Golden City. Mercury and Golden City are 14 hours behind on handicap.

## STORMY SILENT

Outburst (Bobby Bongers) was seventh in line and 10th on handicap at 584 miles from Rio, 92 miles behind Albatros.

Bruynzeel's Stormy, well up with the leaders on the previous day, did not report. Glicksman's Raph was third on handicap, 51 miles behind Fortuna and 8 hours, 20 minutes behind Albatros on handicap.
