## Stormkaap on way back to City

STORMKAAP, the Cape Town entry in the Cape-Rio race which had to put into St. Helena because of rudder trouble, is on the way back to Cape Town.

Dave Abromowitz, the skipper, and his crew thought it might be possible to effect repairs at St. Helena and to carry on to Rio, although officially retired

from the race. As the yacht could not be taken out of the water, the crew's idea of doing the repairs themselves had to be abandoned.

Stormkaap is being transported by Resurgent, a Royal Navy auxiliary, which called at St. Helena on its way to Cape Town. There was some doubt whether Resurgent could lift Stormkaap, which weighs about 14 tons and the Resurgent derricks are limited to about ten tons. It was stated in Cape Town yesterday by the Royal Navy authorities that Stormkaap had been stripped down and the loading successfully accomplished.

Resurgent is also carrying Dave Abromowitz and his crew and is expected in Cape Town on Friday afternoon.
